Original text on scoring (Page 10, Section - Content, Scoring and Instructions):

Respondents scoring 75 points and above will be added to the pre-qualified list for as-needed technical assistance and training services in the Core Content Areas, Modalities, and Settings selected on application.

Revised text on scoring for clarity (Page 10, Section - Content, Scoring and Instructions):

Respondents scoring 75 points and above, **inclusive of a requisite score of at least 25 points in Verification of Minimum Eligibility**, will be added to the pre-qualified list for as-needed technical assistance and training services in the Core Content Areas, Modalities, and Settings selected on application.

Original text on reference checks (Page 10, Section - Content, Scoring and Instructions):

Reference checks, including, but not limited to, prior clients as indicated in Appendix B Prior Project Description(s), may be used to determine the applicability of Respondent experience to the services the City is requesting and the quality of services and staffing provided to prior clients, as well as adherence to schedules/budgets and Respondent's problem-solving, project management and communication abilities, as well as performance on deliverables and outcomes, and effectiveness in meeting or exceeding project objectives.

Revised text on reference checks for clarity (Page 10, Section - Content, Scoring and Instructions):

Reference checks, including, but not limited to, prior clients as indicated **on SurveyMonkey application questions 13-19**, may be used to determine the applicability of Respondent experience to the services the City is requesting and the quality of services and staffing provided to prior clients, as well as adherence to schedules/budgets and Respondent's problem-solving, project management and communication abilities, as well as performance on deliverables and outcomes, and effectiveness in meeting or exceeding project objectives.
