Heath And Air Safety Facility Grant

Renovation and Repair Facility Grant

New information added after the conference.

Air and Safety Grants (small grants)

Announced Amendments/Changes to the Grant:

1. FRCs with less than 2 years on their lease or have other landlord constraints may apply for an A&S grant to cover items that could be moved to a new site if needed.
2. Portable air filters/HVAC systems were inadvertently left off the example of items eligible for the grant.
3. The grant will be dispersed in one lump sum. FRCs will be required to submit proposed budgets, pre-work photos at the beginning and will be required to submit list of actual expenses, final receipts, and photos of completed work at the end.

Question	First 5 Final Response
From Rachel Klegon (Support for Families): How many applications do you anticipate being funded?	All Family Resource Centers are eligible to receive a FRC Air and Safety Grant. A single site may not receive more than one grant (so an agency with multiple FRC contracts cannot get two Air and Safety Grants for the same site).
From Katie Furuyama (she/her), Compass and Rachel Klegon (SFCD) : Can FRCs apply to both opportunities?	Yes, an FRC can apply for and receive both the Air and Safety and Renovation and Repair Grants.
From Mimi Demissew (OFC): can the air safety grants cover purchases already made?	Yes, First 5 SF may require successful applicants to make applicable correction(s) to their FRC CMS budget prior to dispersal, amend past submitted invoices and/or demonstrate the expense has not been charged to another funding source.

Renovation and Repair Grant - New information added after the conference.

Announced Amendments/Changes

1. FRCs may apply for a maximum amount of \$175,000. Applications will be reviewed and scored on a competitive basis. Either a single grant of \$175,000.00 will be awarded or multiple projects making the most significant and realistic impact may be selected (i.e. one project for \$100,000 and a second project for \$75,000).
2. Portable air filters/HVAC systems were inadvertently left off the example of items eligible for the grant.

Question	Final Response from First 5 SF
From Rod Penalosa (Glide): Will the R&R Grant be disbursed in one lump sum, or in multiple disbursements throughout the year?	The answer to this depends on the needs and projected start date of the project.
From Yensing Sihapanya (Family Connections) : What is the max number of the repairs grant will/ can be funded?	We are unable to answer this question other than to say that there has not been a maximum or minimum number of repairs stated.
From Yensing Sihapanya : Will there be possible contract negotiations/ modification after a proposal is accepted for either grants?	Yes, budget modifications can be made with First 5 SF written approval. Awardee(s) will be notified of the process for this at a later date.
From Mimi Demissew : can you please give us the website again	From Shelli Rawlings-Fein (she/her) : https://www.first5sf.org/funding-opportunities/
From Katie Furuyama (she/her), Compass : Can we ask questions if we think of them later?	This bidders conference is the final opportunity to ask questions. Applicants may ask for technical assistance if there are technical problems in completing the Google form (for the Air and Safety Grant) or the Survey Monkey (for the Reno/Repair).
From Theresa Calderon (Glide): Can portable air filtration systems be purchased? For those of us that may be conducting groups in different locations at times?	Portable air filters/HVAC systems were inadvertently left off the example of items eligible for the grant.
From Rachel Klegon : can you explain what you mean by a different approach?	FRCs attending the bidders' conference today should read the posted Q&A which will have final responses to the questions received today. Those responses may indicate a different approach or response than was given today.
